<b>Reading</b>	When you read, stop half way through and tell your grown up what you think might happen next. At the end of the book can you say which part was your favourite part and why, and was there a part you did not like or would change if you were the author?		
<b>Writing</b>	Write about what you have learnt about your chosen country. Write some questions you may still like the answers to. Can you start your questions in different ways?

Encourage the children to look up at the sky regularly and notice how it changes. Talk about the meaning of dawn and dusk and watch what happens to the sky at these times.</p>

<b>Geography</b>	<p>Using the country you have chosen to learn about, compare the physical geography features with those found in Britain. What is the same, what is different about your chosen country?</p>	<p>Print out the continents and ocean map that we have attached. Can you label and then stick the continents in the correct places on the map? Can you stick the ocean labels in the right places too?</p>	<p>Look at your garden or out of the window. Can you spot the features that are manmade and those that are natural? Paint/draw a picture of the view/features you can see. You could also label them.</p>
