

Who painted them? When / how / where were they created?</p> <p>Chose one of the paintings to write about. Use the Looking at Artwork template (see Art resources)</p>	<p>Katie looks at the painting 'Tropical Storm with a Tiger' by Henri Rousseau. Imagine how this painting might look with a different type if weather. Choose another famous painting and recreate it with different environmental conditions</p> <p>Ask people in your family or a group of friends to all draw / paint a picture of the same thing. Compare your pictures and see how all of them are different</p> <p>Set up an art gallery at your home. Don’t forget to give your Art work a title, say who the artist is and the date it was completed.</p>

<p>RE</p>	<p>This term we are thinking about the special relationship between Jews and God and the promises they make to each other.</p> <p>In the Bible God made a promise that he would look after a man called Abraham and all his family and their children and their children and their children and their children and their children. (That is what descendants are.) If you have a Bible it is in Genesis chapter 17, at the beginning of the Bible. You could watch it on YouTube ‘God’s promise to Abraham’. The story of Moses that we learnt about early last term also shows how God looked after his people. Can you remember the story and tell someone in your house? The Jewish people promised God that they would keep the Ten Commandments. If you have a children’s Bible read the Ten Commandments.</p>

r sound spelt wr	No rule	write, written, wrote, wrong, wrap
