Two letters that make one sound are known as a digraph. Three letters that make one sound are a trigraph.

Phase 2 sounds - s/a/t/p/i/n/m/d/g/o/c/k/ck/e/u/r/h/b/f/ff/l/ll/ss

Phase 2 high frequency and tricky words -

You could print out letters or words to practise with but you could also cut up boxes from cereal, tea bags or similar and write a sound or a word on the plain inside of the box. Then you can put the sounds together to make real or alien words. The words can be put together to make sentences, adult or child can do this for each other. Older brothers or sisters could join in.
