We have been reading *Little Red Reading Hood* by Lucy Rowland

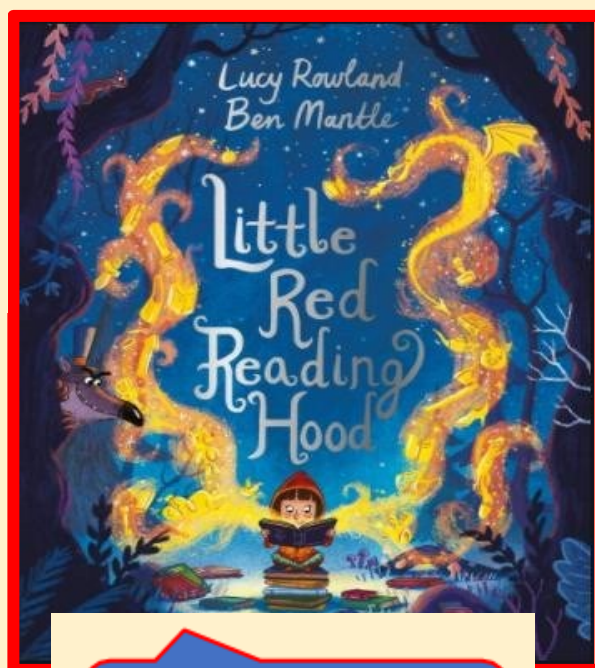
