Tips to avoid your child's property:

- 1. Name it! Every time you wash it check the name is still visible. We find lost items all day and manage to return many items to children's pegs because they are named.
- 2. If your child comes out of class without their property LOOK FOR IT STRAIGHT AWAY—wait until all the children have left the classroom and ask to check the class.
- 3. If you think the item may be un-named keeping checking lost property—sometimes lost items take a while to find their way to lost property.






COVID SOCIAL AWARENESS IN THE COMMUNITY
