COVID GOVERNMENT GUIDELINES



STEP 4 (CURRENTLY MONDAY THE 19TH JULY 2021)

From Monday 19th July, schools no longer have to keep children in consistent groups or bubbles. However, as the rule about close contacts needing to isolate does not change until the 16th August, we have decided to keep bubbles for the last two days of term.

If we do have a positive test after the 19th July we no longer have to undertake contact tracing and close contacts will be identified via NHS Test and Trace.

In line with step 4, we will no longer require parents to wear face masks on the school premises from the 19th July, but we would encourage you to continue to wear them for the last two days of the school term.

We will also keep to the social distancing in place and staggered start and finish times until the end of term.
