Children will get two sets of calculation cards and up to two sets comparison cards.

Children will make as many addition and subtraction comparisons as they can. For example: $4 + 3 > 6 - 4$. Children can record comparisons in their books.

SECURE



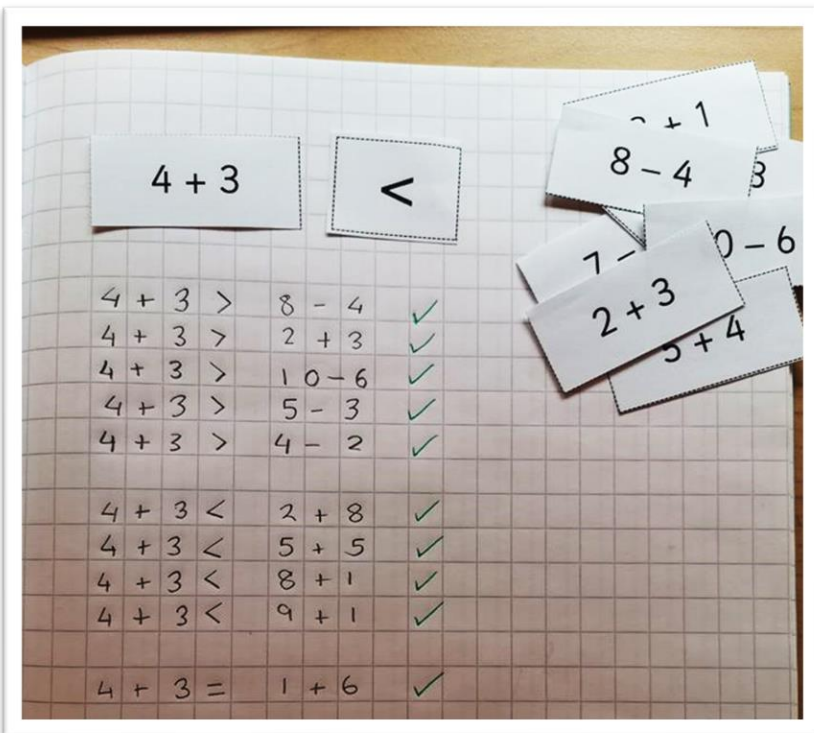
Children will work independently to compare two statements.
