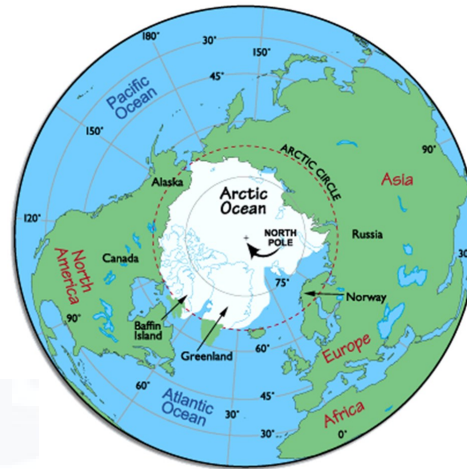
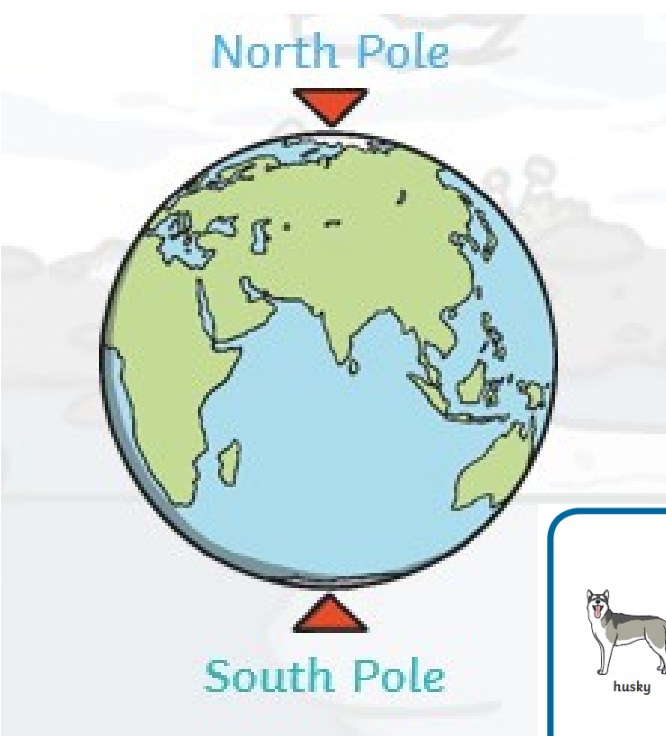


The polar regions are two snowy places at the top and the bottom of the earth. They are called the Arctic (North Pole) and Antarctica (South Pole).

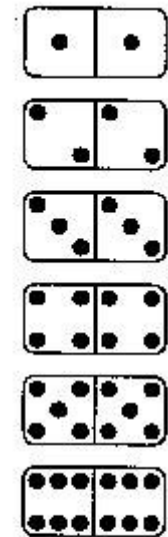



Key Vocabulary	
Arctic	A polar region located at the northern most part of the earth. (North pole).
Antarctic	A polar region located at the southern most part of the earth. (South pole).
ice	Water becomes ice when it gets very cold.
freeze	If water (liquid) is cooled, it changes to ice (solid). This change is called freezing.
melt	As the ice heats up, it melts and turns into water.
camouflage	To hide or disguise something
iceburg	A huge chunk of ice floating in the ocean is called an iceburg
