

# Home learning for Year 1's Far Far Away topic



#### Numeracy

Practise writing numbers to 11 to 20 using the correct formation.

Compare and order the heights, lengths and widths of your teddies using language such as longer/longest/taller/tallest/shorter/shortest/ narrower/narrowest/wider/widest and so forth.

Count forwards and backwards to 50.

Count pairs of things e.g. socks, or count in steps of 2s and 10s. Find things that come in groups of 2 or 10.

## Ivy's Challenge

Talk to your family. What goals do they have? How do they feel when they achieve their goal?

Think of a goal you would like to achieve. What steps do you need to take to get there?

#### Literacy

Write your first and last name with the correct use of upper- and lower-case letters.

Research the country of China, what facts can you find?

Write a letter to someone in your family, e.g. grandparents, asking them about a holiday that they have been on. Where did they go? What was the weather like? How did they get there?

Listen to different stories and poems from around the world.

### **Cross Curricular**

Discuss holidays that you have had in the U.K. and outside of it. Locate your holiday on a map.

Go on a journey and draw the different things you see e.g. hills, forests, rivers.

Read fiction and non-fiction books with links to the seasons, trees or animals.
