Maths

- Carry on learning your number bonds to 10 and 20. For example, using a pack of cards could you find all the ways to make 10 or to make 20.
- Count in objects in groups of 5.
- Find half of a shape
- Play a board game that involves rolling a dice.
- Count forward and backwards to 100 from any starting number.



Literacy

- Find an information book or magazine to read more about plants.
- Ask your family for their favourite plants or flowers and make a list.
- Listen to a story about a plant, tree or flower.
- Share a traditional tale with a member of your family.



Celebrate with Laurie

- Talk to your family about things they feel proud of, for example have they cooked a special meal or grown a beautiful plant in the garden?
- Can you think of something you are proud of? Why not write it on your Laurie Leaf and bring it to school so that we can all share in your success.



Cross Curricular

- Find a plant in the garden and describe it using the Victor Vocabulary words.
- Visit Grey's farm and pick some of their produce when they reopen in May.
- Use fruit to make a cake or pudding.
- Find out which trees our characters comes from.
- Try one of the fun and easy ideas for growing seeds you might find in your fridge at home – no garden needed!
