

This term our focus for the school character is Casev.



Foundation Stage

This term our topic is Splash! We are starting by learning about ponds before moving onto under the sea. To launch our new topic we had a delivery of 5 duck eggs which we have been eagerly watching. There has been much excitement watching the ducklings hatch and we can't wait to give them their first swim and to hold them when they are a bit bigger and stronger. We will be learning about lots different pond and sea creatures, their



features and their habitats. This half term we will also be doing lots of reflecting on our busy but amazing year in Ash and Willow and preparing for the transition to year 1. As well as all of this learning be will also be going on our school trip to Birdworld and having our first sports day.



Year 1

We are at the beginning of our final half term of the year. Time has flown by so quickly and we are proud of all the children and the progress they have made throughout the year. Well done Year One! Our learning adventure for this half term is 'Toy Story'. To further develop our oracy skills, we will be giving all the children the opportunity to share a photograph of one of their treasured toys and to explain why the toy is such a special one. We will also encourage the children to talk to their older family members and our school staff about the toys they enjoyed playing with when they were young. We will have lots of opportunities to look at and handle toys from the past and to discuss how toys have changed over time. We are all keen scientists in Year One, and this half term we will be having lots of fun exploring, naming and describing the properties of everyday materials. You may like to chat with your children about the materials that everyday objects and toys around the home are made from and why. In PSHE, we will be celebrating all the things we have learned, and ways in which we have grown, during our time in Year One. We will discuss how all living things, including ourselves, are always changing. In addition to all the above, we will be reading lots of stories and poems, singing songs, dancing and playing outdoor games, practising for sports day, sewing, gardening and investigating multiplication and division in maths. It looks to be a very busy and exciting half term ahead!

Year 2

Our final topic this year is 'The Great Outdoors,' a Science led topic where we will look at different habitats and how animals and plants have adapted to survive. We will be visiting Windsor Environmental Centre, as part of this topic and carrying out some fieldwork. In Geography we will be considering both local and international environmental issues and thinking about what we can all do to help. Our Maths lessons this half term will concentrate on fractions, time and position and movement. There will also be time to recap previous learning.

Using the books Rang-Tan by James Sellick and Tidy by Emily Gravett we will write descriptions, postcards, fact files and even a letter to the Prime Minister. Finally in Art, we will study the paintings of Henri Rousseau and use them as a stimulus to create our own collage jungle pictures.
