King Harold was king for a short time before being killed at the Battle of Hastings.



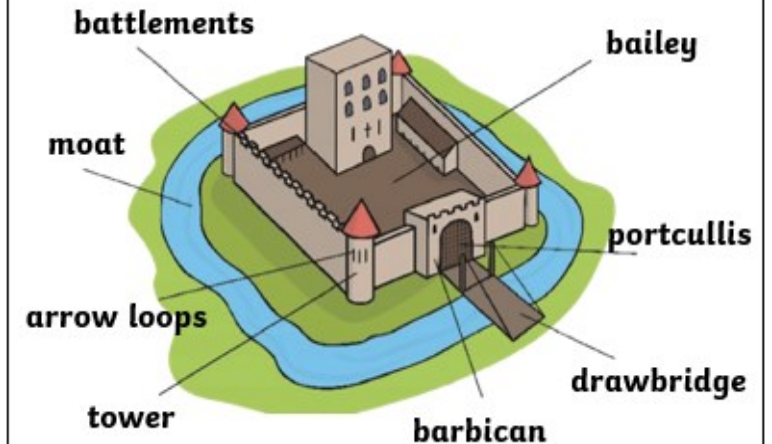
William the Conqueror

<i>atlas</i>	A book of maps or charts
<i>globe</i>	A model of the earth
<i>town</i>	A town is a place where people live and work. There may be shops, places of worship, leisure facilities and schools there. It is bigger than a village but smaller than a city.
<i>city</i>	Like a town but bigger, usually with a cathedral.
<i>country</i>	An area of land with its own government, rules and borders.
<i>capital city</i>	A town or city where the government sits.
<i>UK</i>	The United Kingdom. It is made up of four countries: England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.
